UAE NEWS


- UAE a destination for major corporate HQs in 2025, benefiting from sophisticated legislative system, advanced digital and financial infrastructure, and its geographic location.

ISLAMIC BANKING NEWS

- Total assets of Islamic banks and windows in Oman rose by 17.4%, reaching RO 9.2 billion by the end of June 2025. This accounts for 19.9% of the overall banking sector's assets.
- Riyad Capital, a leading asset manager within KSA & GCC, issued a 3 yr SAR 500mln Sukuk for Sumou Global Investment Company. Issuance marks first of its kind offering for Saudi real estate sector.

GCC NEWS

- Saudi household ownership rate reached 65.4% by end of 2024, surpassing 2025 target of 65%. Report also noted that more than 122,000 families have benefited from housing support last year.
- Oman's Bank Nizwa rolls out e-mandate service for direct debit. Customers can benefit from the flexibility to set up, modify, or cancel authorisations electronically as needed.

COMMODITIES

- Gold hit a more than four-month high, as increased bets for a Fed Reserve rate cut this month lifted bullion's allure, while silver rose above \$40 per ounce first time in more than a decade.
- Oil prices traded in a tight range as worries about rising output and the impact of U.S. tariffs on demand offset supply disruptions stemming from intensified Russia-Ukraine airstrikes.

FOREX NEWS

- USD was adrift on Monday as markets looked ahead to a raft of U.S. labour market data this week that could determine the size of the Federal Reserve's expected rate cut later this month.
- AUD extended gains on Monday as the greenback felt the drag of rate cut wagers, while weak local data foreshadowed another quarter of soft growth for the Australian economy.
