

### ISLAMIC BANKING NEWS

- Gold slipped on Monday as positive U.S.-China trade talks alleviated market fears, leading investors to shift from safehaven assets towards riskier investments.
- Oil rose after both sides in U.S.-China trade talks touted their progress, which lifted market sentiment that they may be moving toward a resolution of their trade dispute.
