- ADNOC Group's have accelerated the integration of advanced AI technologies across their operations, driving growth and boosting operational efficiency.


- SCCI reaffirmed the depth of relations linking the emirate's business community with its counterpart in India, founded on enduring bilateral friendship between the UAE and India.

ISLAMIC BANKING NEWS

- Takaful Malaysia has proposed the establishment of a tier-two subordinated sukuk programme of up to RMIbil in nominal value based on the syariah principle of wakalah bi al-istithmar.
- Gulf International Bank reported that its net profit attributable to shareholders soared to \$44.2 million in the second quarter of 2025, marking an 8% increase from \$41 million.

GCC NEWS

- Aramco has signed an \$11 billion lease and leaseback deal involving its Jafurah gas processing facilities with a consortium of international investors, led by funds managed by GIP.
- Saudi Arabia's inflation falls to 5-month low reaching 2.1% in July. According to data by GASTAT, housing, water, electricity, gas, and fuel prices were the main driver of the increase.

COMMODITIES

- Gold prices were headed for a weekly fall, as hotter-thanexpected U.S. inflation data dented hopes for a super-sized 50basis-point (bps) Federal Reserve rate cut in September.
- Oil prices nudged higher to fresh one-week highs after U.S. President Donald Trump warned of "consequences" if Russia blocked a Ukraine peace deal, injecting concerns about supply.

FOREX NEWS

- USD held on to previous session gains after hotter than expected inflation data prompted traders to trim wagers on rate cuts by the U.S. Federal Reserve.
- AUD was back on the defensive after a high reading on U.S. producer inflation quashed talk of aggressive rate cuts there and boosted the greenback.
