UAE NEWS

- The Central Bank of the UAE (CBUAE) has decided to maintain the Base Rate applicable to the Overnight Deposit Facility (ODF) at 4.40%.
- Masdar in talks on \$200mln solar power deal with Endesa. Deal for the roughly 450MW portfolio builds on existing partnership & further expands Masdar's operations in Spain.
- ADQ has partnered with U.S. private equity firm Energy Capital Partners to invest more than \$25 billion in energy projects to power data centres, mostly in the United States.
- Shuaa Capital issues \$97.7mln MCBs after debt restructuring. Issuance follows exchange offer to holders of its \$150mln bond, which expires end of March following two extensions.
- Fitch Ratings has affirmed United Arab Bank's Long-Term Issuer Default Rating at 'BBB+' with a Stable outlook and upgraded its Viability Rating to 'bb-' from 'b+'.
- G42 and NVIDIA have unveiled a pioneering hybrid weather forecasting system, marking a significant advancement in their Alpowered climate technology collaboration.

- Bapco Energies has successfully completed a \$1 billion 10-year Reg S Sukuk issuance, alongside a capped tender offer for up to 25 per cent of its existing \$1bn 7.5 per cent notes due 2027.
- 🗫 Indonesian coal miner Bukit Makmur Mandiri Utama, raised Rp2trn (\$121.4m) from debut sukuk offering, Largest A+ Sharia-Rated Corporate Sukuk Ijarah in single Issuance in Indonesia.

GCC NEWS

- Bahrain economy projected to hit 2.8% GDP growth in 2025. To attract foreign direct investment (FDI), Bahrain is establishing new industrial free zones in Muharrag
- 🗫 Kuwait's trade surplus with Japan narrowed 47% from a year earlier to JPY 44.1 billion (USD 275 million) in February, down for the first time in two months, due to weak exports.

COMMODITIES

- Gold rose to an all-time high as the U.S. Federal Reserve hinted at two possible interest rate cuts this year, bolstering bullion's appeal amid ongoing geopolitical and economic tensions.
- Oil prices rose, boosted by a strong outlook for demand in the United States after fuel inventories fell more than expected, and a weaker U.S. dollar.

FOREX NEWS

- usd was softer after Fed Reserve indicated rate cuts were likely later this year even as uncertainty around U.S. tariffs weighed, while GBP hit 4-month high ahead of the BoE's policy decision.
- AUD fell after Australian employment posted surprise fall in Feb. ending a strong run of impressive gains, as the red-hot labour market loosened a little, although jobless rate stayed steady.
