UAE NEWS

- CBUAE increased its gold reserves by 25.899% during first five months of the year to AED28.933 billion at the end of May, up from AED22.981 billion at the end of December 2024.
- Private Department of Sheikh Mohamed Bin Khalid Al Nahyan (PD) closed a syndicated AED 3 billion real estate financing deal to refinance its bank debt, settle sukuk obligations.
- Proptech sector in UAE is projected to be valued at AED 5.69 billion by 2030. The market would nearly triple & expand at a compound annual growth rate of 17.49% in five years.
- Masdar achieved portfolio growth of 62% last year, with capacity reaching 51GW. AD gov will support with regular equity injections for brownfield projects to reach 100GW target.
- SEWA to enhance water security in Sharjah via strategic projects worth AED4 billion, ensuring that treated water can be effectively delivered to Sharjah and the Central Region.
- CE-Ventures announced its participation in the \$100 million Series B funding round for leading US nuclear technology company Aalo Atomics.



ISLAMIC BANKING NEWS

- Kuwaiti government plans to borrow 3-6 billion Kuwait dinars (\$10-20 billion) in fiscal year 2025/26 through conventional and Islamic instruments as the fiscal deficit widens.
- Egypt Healthcare Authority held talks with Abu Dhabi Islamic Bank (ADIB) Egypt to explore a strategic partnership in healthcare investment and digital transformation.

GCC NEWS

- Total assets of commercial banks in Qatar expanded by 2.8% MoM during June to QR2,125tn. Total assets moved up 3.8% in June. Assets grew by an average 5.7% over past five years (2020-24).
- Saudi Arabia's crude oil exports slipped in June to their lowest level in 3 months. Crude exports from world's largest oil exporter fell to 6.141 million barrels per day, from 6.191 million bpd in May.

COMMODITIES

- Gold was little changed as investors awaited cues on Federal Reserve's policy outlook ahead of annual economic symposium at Jackson Hole, Wyoming, which starts later in the day.
- Oil prices gained slightly as larger-than-expected declines crude oil and fuel inventories in the U.S., the world's biggest oil user, supported expectations for steady demand.

FOREX NEWS

- USD drifted as investors fretted about Fed's independence after another attack from Trump ahead of remarks from Chair Jerome Powell later this week that could influence rates outlook.
- CAD steadied, with currency holding near 3-month low after it was pressured by inflation data that raised expectations the Bank of Canada would resume its easing campaign.
