- Abu Dhabi National Energy Company (TAQA) secured AED8.5 billion term loan to drive growth. This two-year AED-denominated floating-rate loan has 1-year extension option.
- Masdar has been assigned a 'AA-' credit rating with a stable outlook by S&P Global Ratings, reinforcing its position as a global clean energy leader.
- The Private Department of UAE's Sheikh Mohamed Bin Khalid Al Nahyan LLC (PD) has closed a syndicated 3 billion UAE dirhams (\$813 million) real estate financing deal.
- DP World inks (MoU) with Japan's ITOCHU Corporation to expand logistics, supply chain infrastructure, and distribution capabilities in sub-Saharan Africa.
- Mastercard and First Abu Dhabi Bank (FAB) have launched five new credit cards in six months, redefining the strong relationship between the two companies.
- CBUAE in collaboration with Al Nasr Sports
 Club, issued commemorative silver coins to

ISLAMIC BANKING NEWS

- Saudi's SHL Finance Co secured banking facility of SAR 200 million with Saudi Investment Bank. The Sharia-compliant financing to be used to provide new loans, to boost revenues & support growth.
- Saudi Arabia's Perfect Presentation for Commercial Services (2P) signed a deal with Arab National Bank, raising its facility to SAR 135 million, to help fund new ventures.

GCC NEWS

- Oman's total non-oil exports rose by 9.1% to R03.260bn between January and June 2025, compared with R02.989bn in the same period of 2024: National Centre for Statistics and Information.
- Qatar's Al Faleh Educational Holding to enhance foreign ownership to 100% from 49%, to attract additional investment, enhance market liquidity, and broaden the shareholder base.

COMMODITIES

- Gold edged lower while investors awaited U.S. Fed Chair Jerome Powell's speech at the annual Jackson Hole symposium that could offer fresh clues on the monetary policy path.
- Oil little changed but were on track to snap a 2-week losing streak as hope for immediate peace between Russia & Ukraine dimmed, increasing the risk premium demanded by oil sellers.

FOREX NEWS

- USD steady on Friday, poised for a strong weekly performance as investors gear up for an eagerly anticipated speech from the Fed Chair that could shape the near-term path for interest rates.
- JPY weakened after core inflation in Japan slowed for a second straight month in July but stayed above BoJ's 2% target, keeping alive expectations for a rate hike in the coming month.
