ISLAMIC BANKING NEWS

- Malaysia: Bank Simpanan Nasional has set price guidance on a multi-tranche sukuk offering at 3.71%-3.76% for 2-year tranche, 3.75%-3.8% for 3-year tranche & 3.9%-3.95% for 5-year tranche.
- KSA, Jabal Omar Development signed a US\$507mln Murabaha facility to accelerate completion of phases under-construction on company's flagship mega-development project.

GCC NEWS

- Omani banks listed on the Muscat Stock Exchange (MSX) recorded net profits of RO453.5 million in 2023, up 18.6% from RO382.3 million in 2022.
- Qatar Gas Transport Company, Nakilat, and its joint ventures, the group, recorded a consolidated net profit of \$409 million, while its revenue surged by 5.7% to hit \$1.2 billion.

COMMODITIES

- Gold prices rose as escalating tensions in M.E. lifted bullion's safe-haven appeal, while moves were limited as traders awaited U.S. Fed Reserve's remarks for cues on rate trajectory.
- Oil prices climbed on Monday after an attack on U.S. forces in Jordan raised concerns of a wider conflict in the oil-rich Middle Fast.

FOREX NEWS

- USD steady as investors took stock of U.S. economic data ahead of Federal Reserve policy meeting, while escalating M.E. geopolitical tensions kept risk sentiment in check.
- AUD traded cautiously having failed to break higher the previous week, while a set of tests loomed ahead of an Aussie inflation report and Federal Reserve meeting.
