UAE NEWS

- UAE telecoms group e& has posted a net profit of AED3.5 billion (\$953 million) for Q2 2025, a 9.7% increase year-on-year, on the back of a 13% rise in its subscriber base.
- RAK Tourism Development Authority reported record-breaking performance for H1-2025, with over 654,000 visitor arrivals, marking 6% YOY increase & a 9% rise in tourism revenues.
- Arada has reported a tripling of sales during H1-2025 to AED9.15 billion as healthy demand for premium residential property continues to lift markets across the UAE.
- Abu Dhabi's hotel sector recorded total revenues of AED682 million during May. Abu Dhabi's hotels welcomed approximately 481,000 guests in May 2025.
- DFM reports net profit before tax of AED777.1 million in H1-25, up 298%, underscoring strong investor confidence & continued expansion of Dubai's capital markets.
- PureHealth Holding revenue for H1-25 surged by 9% to AED13.6 billion (\$3.7 billion) driven by broad-based growth across both its healthcare and insurance cover verticals.

ISLAMIC BANKING NEWS

- Total bids received for July 2025 auction of UAE AED-denominated T-Sukuk amounting to AEDI.lbln reached AED5.35bln, an oversubscription of 5 times, reflecting investor's strong confidence.
- Bahrain Islamic Bank (BisB) becomes the first bank in Bahrain, GCC, and Middle East to win the 'Most Innovative Solution Award' from ISACA Global Achievements Awards 2025

GCC NEWS

- Saudi Arabia's budget deficit narrowed to 34.534 billion riyals (\$9.21 billion) in the second quarter, marking a 41.1% decline from the previous quarter, as oil and other revenues rose.
- Saudi Arabia's real GDP grew by 3.9% in Q2-2025. Non-oll activities recorded the highest growth at 4.7%, followed by oil activities at 3.8% and government activities at 0.6%.

COMMODITIES

- Gold prices traded flat on Friday, but were on track for a weekly loss as pressure from a stronger dollar outweighed support from trade uncertainty caused by U.S. tariffs.
- Oil prices little changed after falling more than 1% as traders digested the impact of new higher U.S. tariffs that may curtail economic activity and lower global fuel demand growth.

FOREX NEWS

- USD headed for its best week in almost three years against its major peers, maintaining momentum after U.S. President Donald Trump set new tariff rates on dozens of trade partners.
- GBP headed towards its largest monthly loss against USD since Sept2022, reflecting growing confidence among investors in U.S. economy outlook & increasing pessimism over the British one.
