UAE NEWS

- Dubai's GDP grew 4.4% to reach AED241 billion in the first half of the year. In the second quarter alone, Dubai's GDP climbed 4.7% to AED 122 billion.
- Dubai Islamic Bank, A3/A (Moody's/Fitch), has mandated banks to lead a proposed US dollar five-year sustainability-linked sukuk. Investor calls for the Reg S deal begin today.
- ADIPEC 2025 closed with another recordbreaking year, delivering US\$46 billion through 35,000 cross-sector deals & bringing together a record 239,709 attendees, 17% up from 2024.
- Rank of Sharjah successfully acted as Joint Lead Manager and Bookrunner in the issuance of a US\$550 million five-year senior unsecured Sukuk for Ittihad International Investment LLC.
- Family businesses contribute around 60% of UAE's GDP, account for more than 80% of employment, & represent nearly 90% of all private-sector companies in UAE: MoET.
- Abu Dhabi state oil firm ADNOC's trading unit plans to increase the volume it handles by two-thirds over the next few years as part of its international expansion: Bloomberg.

ISLAMIC BANKING NEWS

- GCC debt market sees a flurry of bond, sukuk issuances. Sovereigns and corporates are taking advantage of favourable interest rates and tight borrowing costs.
- Qatar Islamic Bank secures four awards at Asset Triple A Islamic Finance Awards 2025. These recognitions underscore the Bank's continued leadership across all banking segments.

GCC NEWS

- Pace of growth of GCC economies will accelerate in the coming years to reach 4.3% by 2027, supported by expanding investments in tourism, renewable energy, manufacturing, & tech sectors.
- There has been a 9% increase in remittances of expatriates in Saudi Arabia during September 2025, reaching approximately SR13.4 billion, compared to the same period in 2024: SAMA.

COMMODITIES

- Gold prices rose on Monday, buoyed by expectations of another Federal Reserve interest rate cut in December and a slew of weak economic data that raised global growth worries.
- Oil prices rose on optimism that the U.S. government shutdown could end soon and lift demand in the world's top oil consumer, offsetting concerns about rising supplies globally.

FOREX NEWS

- USD held firm as a string of weak economic data revived global growth worries, though signs that Congress may be edging closer to a deal that could reopen U.S. gov blunted its safety bid.
- GBP was headed for its third straight weekly loss against USD and EUR as investors digested the BoE's rate decision and looked ahead to the government's budget later this month.
