GCC NEWS

- MoneyHash, a leading payment orchestration platform, has partnered with noon payments, to streamline access to localized payment methods across the GCC region

COMMODITIES

- Gold prices rose, as fears of a weakening U.S. labour market eclipsed inflation concerns ahead of an expected Federal Reserve rate cut next week.
- Oil prices edged lower over concerns about possible softening of U.S. demand and broad oversupply that offset worry about supply disruption from conflict in the ME and war in Ukraine.

FOREX NEWS

- USD remained under pressure as a surge in U.S. jobless claims and a modest tick up in inflation kept investors zeroed in on likely Federal Reserve interest rate cuts next week and beyond.
- AUD was at a 10-month high against USD as soft U.S. data added to the case for several more rate cuts there, while bullish price signals pointed to further gains in the months ahead.
