- Emirates Islamic Bank priced its \$500 million sustainability-linked sukuk at a spread of 95 basis points over 5-year U.S. Treasuries. Orderbook exceed US\$1.2bn (excl. JLM Interest).
- National Central Cooling Company "Tabreed" confirmed shareholder approval for an interim dividend of 6.5 fils per share, representing AED184.9 million, for the first half of 2025.
- SA Bullion has launched its next-generation digital trading platform, revolutionising how investors buy, sell, and store physical gold in real time
- Dubai's Binghatti Holding explores potential IPO at a time when Dubai property prices are soaring. The developer is planning to hire banks to help it go public in the UAE.
- Mashreq launches digital retail bank in Pakistan, Mashreq Bank Pakistan, aiming to offer unparalleled digital banking solutions, built to be fully Shariah compliant.
- ADQ, Azerbaijan Investment Holding, signed a MoU to examine prospects in the financial services sector, with particular emphasis on initiatives that deepen market connectivity.

ISLAMIC BANKING NEWS

- KSA's Bank AlJazira, priced its dollar-denominated, benchmark perpetual non-call 5.5-year ATI sukuk on par, with a profit rate of 6.5% and a reset margin of +284.7 bps.
- Saudi Pharmaceutical Industries and Medical Appliances Corp. secured a Shariah-compliant SAR 200 million (\$53.3 million) credit facility from Saudi National Bank to fund its operations.

GCC NEWS

- Saudi stock market is one of fastest-growing globally, with market capitalization reaching \$2.4 trillion at the end of Q2-25. Vision 2030 has set a clear path to strengthen & diversify economy.
- Qatar real estate and rental activities sector contributed 7.4% to GDP with value added reaching QRI3.44 billion in Q1-25. Sector registered a growth of 7% compared to Q1-24.

COMMODITIES

- Gold eased due to a slight uptick in the dollar and profit-taking after bullion touched a record high in the previous session on expectations of a Federal Reserve interest rate cut.
- Oil prices held steady in early trading, after rising more than 1%, on drone attacks on Russian ports and refineries, while traders awaited an expected rate cut from the U.S. Federal Reserve.

FOREX NEWS

- USD loitered near four-year lows against EUR and a one-month trough against JPY, as traders geared up for a near-certain interest rate cut from the Federal Reserve later in the session.
- INR is poised to build on its recent recovery, supported by a drop in the dollar and U.S. Treasury yields, with the market focus firmly on the Federal Reserve's upcoming policy verdict.
