UAE NEWS

- Dubai underlined its status as a leading hub for FDI, ranking No.1 globally in terms of the number of Greenfield FDI projects it attracted for eighth consecutive half-year period since H2 2021.
- Dubai-based construction and engineering firm ALEC Holdings has shared its price range between 1.35 UAE dirhams (\$0.367) and 1.40 dirhams (\$0.40) per share, ahead of its IPO.
- UAE construction output set to grow 22% to \$130bln by 2029. Total value of construction output across the Emirates has been increasing steadily since start of the decade.
- UAE real estate developer Arada acquired a 75% stake in British developer Regal, marking its second international foray after launching its Australia business last year.
- Binghatti Holding Limited, rated Ba3 by Moody's and BB- by Fitch, has mandated banks for its inaugural USD Reg S senior unsecured long three-year green sukuk.
- OCI Global and Orascom Construction are pursuing a potential merger to establish a global infrastructure and investment platform headquartered in Abu Dhabi.

ISLAMIC BANKING NEWS

- Islamic banks accounted for 28% of the total assets of Qatar's banking sector. The assets of Islamic banks in the country grew by 3.9% to QR585.5bn in 2024.
- Kuwait Finance House ranked 1st for Best Performing Bank in Kuwait, for The Banker's Top 1000 Global Banks Rankings 2025. This ranking underscores KFH's exceptional financial performance.

GCC NEWS

- Qatar's economy maintained growth in Q2-25 despite challenging global context, with real GDP rising by 1.9% driven primarily by non-hydrocarbon activities, which expanded by 3.4%.
- Qatar National Bank, rated Aa2 Stable by Moody's, A+ Stable by S&P, and A+ Stable by Fitch, has issued a mandate for its inaugural EUR benchmark five-year Reg S fixed rate green bond.

COMMODITIES

- Gold steadied after reaching record high, underpinned by expectations of more U.S. rate cuts & weaker USD, as investors awaited Fed Chair Powell's speech for further policy cues.
- Oil prices declined, as a preliminary agreement reached between Iraq & Kurdish regional governments to restart an oil pipeline added to oversupply concerns.

FOREX NEWS

- USD faced continued pressure in early trading in Asia on Tuesday as traders analyzed comments by members of the Federal Reserve for clues on the path of interest rates.
- INR is expected to remain under strain on Tuesday despite a dip in the dollar with steep U.S. tariffs and visa fee increases denting sentiment towards the Asian currency.
